The local branch of the Cascadia Green Building Council has designed a new public washroom for Art Gibbons Memorial Park in Rosemont, Nelson. The goal of this project is to construct a demonstration net-zero energy building that showcases healthy, local, energy conserving materials.

The building will be constructed with local clay and wood-chips, a vegetated green roof, and locally-sourced, forest stewardship certified (FSC) timbers.

Construction is set to begin in April, 2012 and is scheduled to be completed by September, 2012.
